Day	Activity	Meals Provided	Details
17 - Wed	Travel	No	The group will rendezvous in Miami and leave for Santa Cruz, Bolivia on American Airlines. We will schedule the group on a 3:00 p.m. flight to Bolivia. You will stay in a hotel in Santa Cruz overnight.
18 - Thurs	Travel to Cochabamba - get settled. Evening welcome ceremony with Mano a Mano - Bolivia.	Yes	Morning flight to Cochabamba. Settle in at selected lodging accommodations - Apart Hotel Regina. Late lunch together. Brief overview of Mano a Mano counterpart organizations following lunch. Free afternoon. Early evening dinner and welcome ceremony at offices of Mano a Mano - Bolivia.
19 - Fri	Travel to rural community - prep a Mano a Mano - Bolivia project	Yes	Travel to a rural community in which Mano a Mano - Bolivia has built a clinic, school and/or housing for teachers. Prepare the project for its dedication. May involve equipping a clinic, furnishing a duplex in which teachers will live or furnishing a school. Stay overnight in the community.
20 - Sat	Attend the dedication of the project	Yes	Mano a Mano - Bolivia staff and volunteers and hundreds of community residents will participate in this several-hour-long ceremony and celebration. Return to Cochabamba in evening.
21 - Sun	Free morning and afternoon Evening learning/discussion about Bolivia	Dinner	Morning and afternoon available for relaxing and sight seeing. Cochabamba has lovely parks, the world's largest statue of Christ, the Patino mansion and other interesting sights. Evening: Discussion of Bolivia's history, economy and political situation with Bolivian professor over dinner together.
22 - Mon	Visit Mano a Mano - Nuevo Mundo projects	Yes	Visit Nuevo Mundo offices and hear about their programs. Travel to rural community of Choquechampi to visit recently completed water reservoir. Lunch there. . Then visit a water project under construction to see first-hand how projects are built. Dinner together with Nuevo Mundo staff.
23 - Tues	Day trip to rural community of Japo	Yes	The residents of Japo have formed a cooperative through which they produce and sell Bolivia's finest weavings. Mano a Mano has purchased weavings from this cooperative to sell in the Twin Cities. Visitors will observe the weavers at work and have an opportunity to make purchases. Mano a Mano also operates a clinic in Japo that travelers will have an opportunity to visit.
24 - Wed	Visit Mano a Mano - Apoyo Aereo in morning; afternoon free	Yes	Morning - visit Apoyo Aereo offices and hangar and hear about their projects. Afternoon free for shopping. Other possibilities include visiting the women's prison
25 - Thurs and 26 - Fri	Open for travel within Bolivia	No	Those who wish to hire the Mano a Mano aircraft may fly to the high altitude salt beds, the area in which the film "The Gift of Pacha Mama" was filmed. Other options include visiting Sucre, a beautiful old Spanish city and original capitol of Bolivia, or the dinosaur tracks of Toro Toro. Fly to Santa Cruz in the evening. Stay overnight in a hotel.
27 - Sat	Return to US	No	Fly from Santa Cruz to Miami and on home.
